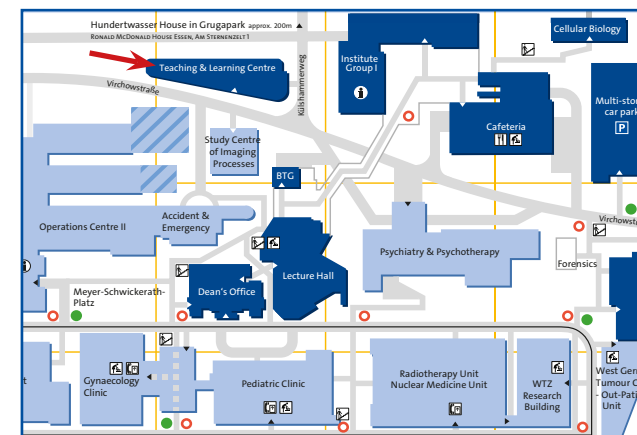

From Essen central station, you can take various means of transportation to arrive at the University Hospital in only a few minutes.

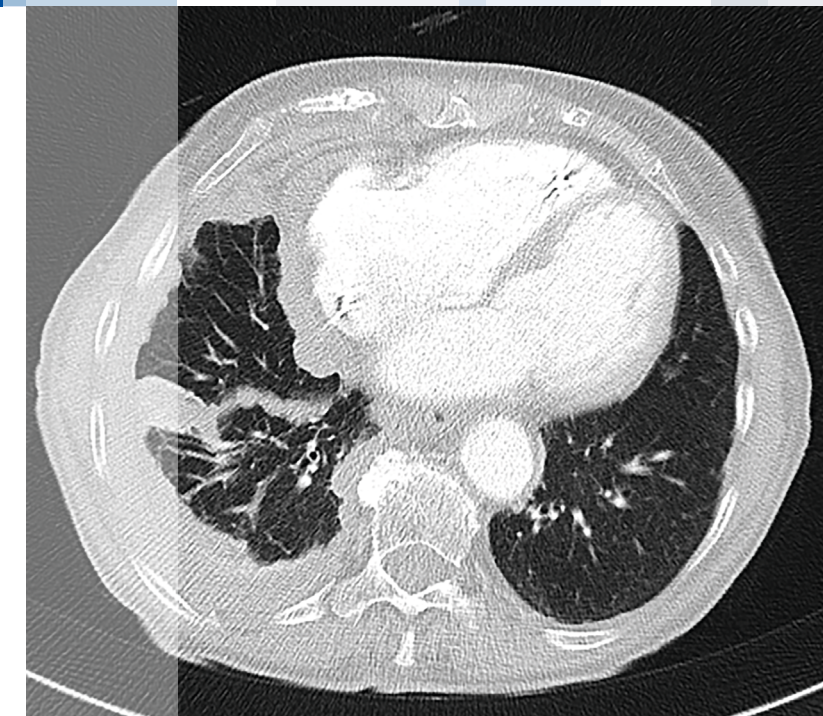
SUBWAY: route U17 to 'Holsterhauser Platz'
